The Parish of St. Brendan's would like to invite you to enroll your child/children in the 2024 Sacramental Program.

The Church teaches us that parents are the first educators of their children - whether it is teaching them how to walk, talk, ride a bike, play with their friends or how to experience their faith. As people of God, it is one of our responsibilities to share our faith with our children.

Our Sacramental Program is parish based, family centered, and school supported. The program aims to support you and your child, while you grow together in the knowledge and expression of your faith. During the program children will be completing their initiation into the Catholic Church. That is, the children prepare for and celebrate the Sacraments of Confirmation and First Eucharist. Children will also prepare for and celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

If you would like your child to participate in the program but **they are not baptised or were baptised outside of the Catholic Church**, please contact the Sacramental Coordinator for more clarification.

A program is also available **for Secondary school aged children** the preparation dates are slightly different to the attached list (currently under construction) Please contact the Sacramental Coordinator for further information.
